- 2. Abstracts must be received by 11:59 PM Eastern on September 1, 2018.
- 3. All Abstracts submitted must be limited to 250-words or less and represent original work. (Most descriptions of presentation content, objectives or speaker experience are required to be 250 words or less.)
- 4. Because the review process is blinded, abstract or poster text should not contain the authors' names, affiliations, or other personal identifying information. Any references to the authors' own work should be made in the third person.

Have an **Abstract** description, **Objectives** (at least 3), <u>provide an outline of the content for each objective</u>. The content cannot be a restatement of the objective. The content must be evidence-based, current and a source must be supplied. The **time frame** (in minutes), your **teaching method** (drop down choice). **Your expertise** and **your biographical information** is also needed. If you have more than one presenter, you will need to include their biographical information for each person presenting.

- 5. The presentation must be at least **60 minutes** long (including a question and answer period).
- 6. Once submitted, abstracts can be edited online. Please make a note of the email confirming your submission.
- 7. The ARIN Planning Committee will review all submitted abstracts to select speakers for the 2019 ARIN Annual Convention.
