Summary of Activities since last report:

The 3rd edition of the Core Curriculum for Radiologic and Imaging Nursing is in the final stage before printing. The indexing is being done and should be completed mid-March. The new front and back cover designs will give the Core a very professional appearance. The Core has increased to over 1025 pages and the page size of the Core has been increased to facilitate easier reading. Nine new chapters are contained within the Core, some have combined topics from older editions and others cover new topics, e.g. forensic radiology, cultural competency and disaster preparedness. Many chapters have additional suggested readings and web resources listed. There is a master glossary at the end of the text. All chapter review questions have been assembled in a separate section at the end of the text.
